property be sold by auction and the proceeds
thereof to be equally divided between my above
named children being the issue of my
former marriage, and in the event of my
getting married again I request that my
wife and the issue of such marriage if any
are to have equal share and proportion as
my above named children and the same
to be paid at the same time by my
Executors hereinafter named. I also request
that all my household furniture and every
thing I may be possessed of at the time of
my decease be sold as aforesaid and the
money arising therefrom to be divided as
aforesaid equally between them. It is also my
wish that in case of my marriage that
my wife should be at liberty to remove all
property whatsoever she may have of her own

to be paid at the same time. I also request
Executors hereinafter named. I also request
that all my household furniture and every
thing I may be possessed of at the time of
my decease be sold as aforesaid and the
money arising therefrom to be divided as
aforesaid equally between them. It is also my
wish that in case of my marriage that
my wife should be at liberty to remove all
property whatsoever she may have of her own
at the time of our marriage and lastly I
name and appoint my brother Daniel Bassett
of Saint Mary Hill and John Lewis of
Treforest Joint Executors of this my last
will and testament who shall execute
all necessary power under this my will
for carrying its intention into Execution
